




## Sir Arthur Conan Doyle 1859-1930

- \* Father was a chronic alcoholic
- Adored his mother who had a passion for books and story telling
- Spent 7 years in Jesuit boarding school
- Decided on a medical career » studied under Dr. Bryan Charles Walker » met Dr. Joseph Bell
- After obtaining his degree, Conan Doyle briefly travelled to Africa
- ❖ March1886 he started "A Study in Scarlet" » the world's introduction to Sherlock Holmes and Dr. John Watson



## Sherlock Holmes

- Inspiration for the character stemmed from Dr. Joseph Bell
  - A master of observation, logically deduction and diagnosis
- The Sherlock Holmes stories quickly gained popularity, primarily published in *The Strand Magazine*, where illustrations were also done of the famous detective.
- There are 4 novels and 56 short stories featuring Holmes


## Deductive versus Inductive

- Deductive Reasoning
  - Logical reasoning from the general to the particular
  - ❖I.e. "all men are mortal; Socrates is a man; therefore, Socrates is mortal"

- ❖Inductive Reasoning
  - Logical reasoning from particular instances to general theories
