Read London. Walk London. Know London.

Visits:

- Walks through London neighborhoods with stops at various local places or sites of interest
- Sherlock Holmes Museum, Charles Dickens Museum, John Keats House, St. Pancras Old Churchyard, Hampton Court
- Performance of a Shakespeare play at the Globe and two contemporary plays/productions
- Possible day trips: Harry Potter Studios, the Brontë Parsonage Museum in Yorkshire, or J. Austen's Bath

Starting from your lodgings in **Marylebone**, walk in the footsteps of famous writers and their characters. Discuss detective stories in the **Sherlock Holmes Museum** outside **Regent's Park**. Look for Harry Potter on King's Cross Station platform 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ in **St. Pancras**. Explore Dr. Samuel Johnson's House in **The Old City of London** and visit Ye Olde Cheshire Cheese pub. Like Belinda in Pope's "The Rape of the Lock," cruise down the Thames to Hampton Court. Imagine Charles Dickens at work while visiting his home in **Clerkenwell**. Haunt the labyrinthine allies of Soho with Dr. Jekyll/Mr. Hyde. Be a groundling in Shakespeare's Globe in **Southwark**. Mingle with artists and bohemians of **Shoreditch**, and with the business crowd of the City. Take in the views from **Hampstead Heath**. And more.

Fly high and low! Visit museums and pubs, theaters, and back alleys. Experience both the great art and the cutting-edge fads of London. Savor its grand historical beauty as well as its electrifying modern diversity. Investigate the porous boundaries and mutual influences between literature and popular culture. Seeing the places you read about will help you understand how London itself is a "character" in these diverse texts.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all university students with a minimum 2.50 GPA. Priority is given to regularly registered UW-Stevens Point students, but students from other universities and community members are welcome to apply.

CREDITS

All participants are enrolled in **three credits** of **ENGL 395: Workshop in English**. Ask your adviser how the course might apply to your major or minor.

INCLUDED IN PROGRAM

Lodging, partial meals, tours, lectures, UW System mandated health insurance, and three credits of Wisconsin resident undergraduate tuition (Minnesota residents qualify for tuition reciprocity; surcharge for other Midwest and non-residents). 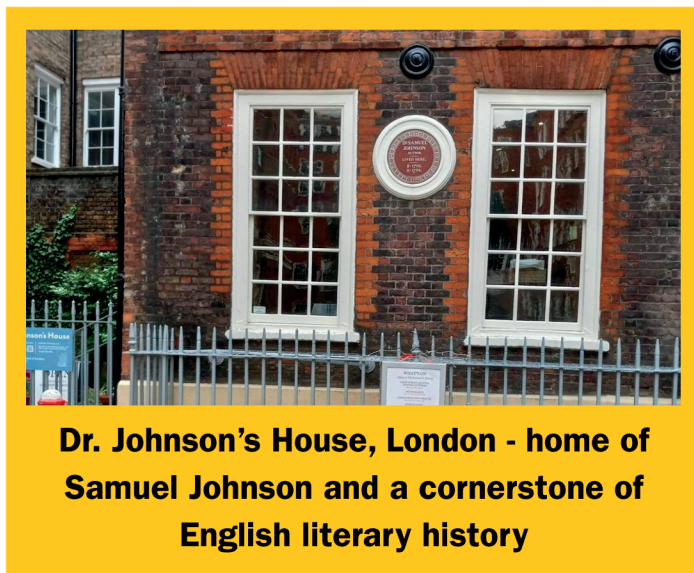
